Agnus McCurdy - Born in Birmingham England father Scottish wife Mary Ann nee JONES who lived to 104. In 1880 came to NZ as a Telegraphist and electrician for the Telegraph department and was dismissed in 1904 for secondary employment activities as organiser for New Zealand Farmers Union (now Federated Farmers). In 1908 He was on the Town Board as Town Clerk, Health officer and inspector of Nuisances. His salary was £50. 1891 He started to build a lodge on opposite side of the River to Whakatiki Street and named it Bonnie Glen, the lodge was to be used as a Hotel for Hunters of deer which he intended to introduce. The lodge was never finished. He built the first picture Theatre. It was the first Theatre in Upper Hutt to have talkies. He was a publisher, editor and reporter of Upper Hutt's first newspaper. He was Upper Hutt's first Mayor the election was on the 26th February 1926. He had four terms as Mayor 1926-27, 1931-33, 1933-35, 1935-38. He died in 1941 at the age of 90.
