John MCHARDIE was born about 21 May 1823 in Scotland. His parents were Elizabeth and Robert McHardie.

The first of John's family to arrive in New Zealand was David MCHARDIE who departed on the ship "Lady Nugent" and arrived in Port Nicholson Wellington on 17 March 1841. The next was Alexander MCHARDIE who departed on the ship "Lord William Bentinck" and arrived in New Zealand on 19 May 1841. Alexander was killed in a logging accident in 1852 and his widow and family later returned to Kirriemuir.

John MCHARDIE departed on the ship "Arab" and arrived in New Zealand on the 16 October 1841 along with his sister Isabella and her husband David SMITH. The SMITH family farmed at Silverstream for many years.

Mr French was called to the chair and after addressing the meeting and explaining the cause of its being called, read his Excellency the Governor's Proclamation, also for the further information of the meeting the leading article of the Wellington Independent, of the 13th inst., remarking at the same time every information was so plainly set forth in it that any comment would be useless. The meeting being proposed, by Mr Freeland, and seconded by Mr T Wilkie. The seconder made the following observations, his reason for seconding it was the amount of property that would be left unprotected, were the Militia which may be drawn in this neighbourhood quartered away from it. The Upper Hutt being a Mill district containing three timber Mills, employing about 60 men, and if an attack were made upon those mills would cause the stoppage of the principal trade of the place, and be the ruin of many families. It was then proposed by Mr Hesse and seconded by Mr Player "That a petition be forwarded to Major W Rawson Trafford, commander in chief of the Militia Forces offering the male adult population of the Upper Halt as Volunteers to serve, as Militia, and to do duly as he may think at, from Stokes Valley to the Mungaroa. After some little discussion upon the proposition it was put to the meeting and carried unanimously. A proposition was then passed that a deputation wait on Major Trafford with the petition, and Mr French and Mr Heese, were chosen as the delegates, the expenses being defrayed by the meeting, and the following morning appointed for the delivery of the petition and interview with the Commanding Officer.

At the close of the above meeting a petition to his Honor the Superintendent was presented to the meeting praying him to have the Upper Hutt Gazetted as a town, to be named by the present meeting. It was proposed, seconded and carried unanimously that the name of the town be McHardie Town, and on the carrying the proposition, the chairman remarked he did not think a better name could have been chosen. He was sure he (Mr McHardie) was the only land owner, in the neighbourhood who had assisted the working man in getting himself a little home and comforts about him, it was his land that bad been cut into small sections and caused settlers to come up, it was he who had given the settlers the comfort and produce of their gardens, it was he, who was getting the land cleared, improved an cultivated, and he the chairman would merely, direct the attention of the meeting to the side of the road where Mr McHardie section was improving daily and to the opposite side of the road sections and see what had been done in the shape of improvement there. In conclusion the chairman regretted as chairman it had not been in his power to make the proposition, but felt satisfied the neighbourhood was now worthy to become a town and it could not hear, a more worthy name than the one which had been proposed and carried. The petition then received the signatures of the meeting which was unanimously attended, and after returning thanks to the chairman, separated about 10 o'clock. -Edward Player.

Dear Madam,

I have been very interested to read in "The Evening Post" (Wellington) of the restoration work that is being carried out at the Wallaceville Blockhouse. It seems to me that this would be an appropriate time to correct the spelling of the name by which the area on which the Blockhouse stands and the street which runs nearby are known. The names should be McHardie's clearing and McHardie's Street respectively. The spelling McHardy in use at present is incorrect.

Both the reserve and the street take their names from an early settler, John McHardie, who came to New Zealand at the age of 18 from Kirriemuir, Scotland, on the immigrant ship "Arab" [?] in 1841. Arriving at Port Nicholson, he joined his elder brother David McHardie, who with his wife and family had arrived a few months earlier and had taken an area of land on the Hutt River. Sometime later John acquired a section of land for himself nearby.

About 1865 – there is some doubt about the date – John acquired an area of land – some 60 acres or more – in Upper Hutt. The Crown Grants confirming the purchase are dated 1880, but are made retrospective to 1856. This retrospective confirmation was a common practice in those days.

2. This land included the site of the present Blockhouse and of a hotel of which he became landlord and which was named – presumably by him – the Highland Home Hotel. As the proprietor of this hotel John McHardie was well known in the district, being familiarly known as 'Scot' McHardie.

In 1865 John McHardie sold the Upper Hutt property and took up a large area of land in the Rangitikei district, alongside a similar one purchased at the same time by his brother David from Lower Hutt. A road which joins the Main North Road about 3 miles north of Bulls was later constructed to pass through their properties, and still bears the name McHardie's Road – correctly spelt this time!

It seems to me that in justice to the memory of the pioneer who purchased and cleared the land and was a prominent citizen in the district, as well as in the interest of historical accuracy, the correct spelling should be restored and I wish to enter a strong plea that this be done. I

should be grateful therefore if you would bring this matter before the City Council with a view to having the change of spelling made.

3. I am sure that in making this request I would have the support of the many McHardie descendants now living in New Zealand (though the majority of them no longer bear the McHardie name). There are many McHardys also living in New Zealand, but, of course, they have no connexion with the McHardie family.

May I add that I have a personal interest in this matter as I am myself a great-grandson of David McHardie, brother of John McHardie, after whom the clearing and the adjacent street are named.

B: Other information related to John McHardie

The 'standard' history of Upper Hutt, J.A. Kelleher's Upper Hutt: The History (Cape Cately/Upper Hutt City Council; 1991) has three very brief references to McHardie. The most substantial of these describes how in the 1850s, the Trentham area around Fortune Lane developed its own hotel, the Highland Home, John (Scot) McHardie licensee. It was to these premises that the Rose of Sharon Lodge came for a meeting venue, after their formation at The Shepard, Upper Hutt, in 1857. McHardie was a brother Lodge member. It was on these premises, on 23 March, 1860, that a public meeting was called to discuss protection for the settlers from attack in the continuing land wars." (Kelleher p.48).

The two other references in this book basically repeat this information. The Rose of Sharon Lodge was a "friendly society" affiliated with the International Order of Oddfellows which enjoyed a significant following in Upper Hutt well into the 20th century. The Blockhouse that was built as a result of that 1860 meeting in McHardie's hotel is still standing and images of it can be found on our RECOLLECT website: http://uhcl.recollect.co.nz/nodes/index/q:CJXV
