#Accidents and Deaths Wellington – 24 February - A man named John Conrick 25 years old was found dead in a house in Martin Square yesterday. The medical evidence showed that death was the result of an epileptic seizure resulting from alcohol. The Coroner remarked that at least fifty per cent of the deaths that come under his notice were caused by drink reference Papers past website Southland Times newspaper 25 February 1907

Found Dead - End of a drinking bout - An inquiry into the circumstances attending the death of John Martin Conrick found dead in a house in Martin square was held by the District Coroner (Mr Ashcroft) on Saturday afternoon. Mr John Conrick father of the deceased testified that his son was 25 years of age and had been working at the D.I.C. up till last Friday week. He was a French polisher by trade. The deceased had been addicted to drink for the last three years. He had not seen his son for a week and he was drunk on that occasion. He had been staying in a small place at the back of No 15 Martin square and it was there he had seen him as he was coming out of a fit. He had been sent for. Deceased had been subject to fits for the last three years and had complained of his heart. When he reached the house on Saturday morning the deceased was alive but was insensible and did not speak. He sent his son Edward to get a doctor and when Dr Martin arrived about 9 am he pronounced life to be extinct. Witness believed his son had died in

a fit. Edward Conrick brother of the deceased said he had seen his brother a little after 8.30 pm on Friday when the latter was sitting up in bed. He was drunk then but talking sensibly. Witness wanted him to go home and he said he would go home in the morning if witness would come for him about 10 o'clock. Witness called at 8.55 pm on Saturday and found deceased lying on his right side with his feet out of bed and a pillow lying on his head as if it had been put there. Henry Hoadwick with whom the deceased had been staying the previous day said he had had a glass or a glasses and a half of liquor with deceased about 2 or 3 pm on Friday. When deceased took a fit about 3 pm he was perfectly sober. After witness had loosened his shirt he left to inform the father. Gave him water and a little beer through the night. When he went out at a quarter to 9 o'clock deceased was apparently asleep as usual. Dr Martin testified to finding the man dead. Death was due to an epileptic form of convulsion caused by drink. The attention of the Health Department should be called to the place where deceased had died. The Coroner Yes you'll see to that constable. It is abominable. That man over there (Headwick) has been bottling him up and making him drink. To the jury Gentlemen I should say that at least 50 per cent, of the deaths that come under our notice are due to drink. A verdict was returned in accordance with the medical testimony reference Papers past website New Zealand Mail newspaper 27 February 1907
