Emily Cruickshank was accidently burnt to death at the fern ground Upper Hutt on Wednesday April twenty sixth one thousand eight hundred and seventy one. In witness whereof as well the said Coroner as the said Jurors aforesaid have hereunto set and subscribed their hands and seals the day and year first above written

Information of witnesses severally taken and acknowledged on behalf of our Sovereign Lady the Queen touching the death of Emily Cruickshank at the Schoolhouse Fern Ground Upper Hutt in the Province of Wellington in the Colony above mentioned on Thursday the twenty seventh day of April one thousand eight hundred and seventy one before John George Frederick Wilford one of the Coroners for the said Colony on an Inquisition then and there taken on view of the body of Emily Cruickshank then and there lying dead as follows to wit.

Arthur Faulkner being sworn said that on Wednesday April 26th about eleven o'clock in the morning I was at work near Mr Cruickshank saw mill I heard a whining noise from where the children were playing they were lighting fires abought the logs at first I took no notice but after a little time I saw that one of the children was alight. They were some distance from me at the time probable over a hundred yards I at once went to the child and took off its clothes as quick as possible the outer cloths were destroyed by the fire before I reached her and the rest I took off. The child was then carried into the house deceased severely burnt very much in every part of the body except her feet. Nobody was actually on the spot where the fire originated the elder sister having just left deceased before she got alight. Deceased is five year of age. The child died about four o'clock in the afternoon. Signed A Faulkner.

David Brown being sworn saith that on Wednesday morning I was at work at the bench in the saw mill the first I heard of the child being on fire was from Mrs Cruickshank's who was though the mill saying the children were on fire whence I got out of the mill I saw last witness running towards the children I followed & assisted to tear the clothes off the child. I then started off for the doctor. The fires had been alight the day before I saw one of them children put more wood one the fires the night previous signed David Brown

Suicide at the Upper Hutt - Information reached town yesterday regarding the suicide at the Upper Hutt of a married woman, named <u>Jane Pike</u>. It appears that deceased, who was the wife of <u>Mr Edward Pike</u>, <u>settler</u>, <u>Upper Hutt</u>, had for some days been complaining of a pain in the head. On Saturday last she left her home and proceeded in the direction of the river. Her husband, fearing she intended to destroy herself, as she had developed slight symptoms of insanity a day or two previously, followed her, and arrived at the river side just in time to see her floating away into deep water. She sank almost immediately. By this time five other men had put in an appearance, and one of them, named Charles Chard, jumped into the water and brought the body up from the bottom, when life was found to be extinct. The occurrence was reported to the Coroner, who appointed an inquest to take place at the Provincial Hotel, Upper Hutt, at 2 o'clock this afternoon. Deceased, who was 46 years of age, leaves a large family. *(Reference Papers past website Evening Post newspaper 19 May 1884)*

A researcher said that Edwin Pike was salting a pig near Ebdentown so perhaps they were living in the area to be close to the Cruickshank sawmill.
