12 September 1910 Access to Sections 222 & 223 Block XIV Akatarawa Undersecretary of Lands – In reply to your minute of the 6th instant on your 1910/325 returned herewith I beg to report that Mr Rawson was the owner of land lying between the land in question and a public Road as illustrated by litho sent herewith. M Read's assertion probably refers to Sections 170 & 171 which were never Rawson's – by my own statement refers to Sections 136, 137, 138, 141 which were Rawson's and are bounded by a public road. Rawson died in 1865 before the grant issued to him for Sections 222 and 223 (now under discussion) but the grant was ante-vested and the Executors dealt with the whole Estate. It will be seen that position coloured yellow of Section 110 gave the whole Estate access to yet another Main Coach Road and at the date of acquisition of Sections 222 & 223 by Rawson all the lands coloured were one Estate with access to two roads. For these facts Mr Read can be referred to the titles in the District Land Register's register if he chooses to search signed Chief Surveyor Smith
