Louise RENSHAW was a midwife in Upper Hutt from 1920 to 1927 (Reference Upper Hutt the History by J A Kelleher 1991)

In 1920 Louise RENSHAW was a registered midwife who transformed her home in Victoria Street into a maternity home. Dr Kemp the only doctor in Upper Hutt district and he did minor operations on Louise's dining room table in her lounge. The house burnt down in July 1930. "Nurse Louise Renshaw stands outside her home in Victoria Street. A registered midwife, she transformed her residence into a maternity home on January 12, 1920 (or 1917 in some

accounts). This is considered to have been the first hospital in Upper Hutt. The lounge was used as a theatre and Dr Kemp, the sole doctor, did minor operations on the dining room table. This photograph was taken in 1924. Nurse Elsie Ogilvie (later Elsie Gibbs), Upper Hutt's first Plunket nurse, also stayed here with the Renshaw family during the 1920s. The house used to stand at 5 Victoria Street, one of only three houses in the area at that time. It burned down in the 1930s (Reference 1930 according to the 2005 article & picture used in "Upper Hutt - The History" page 245)

It was also printed in the 'Leader' on November 14, 1989, with Nurse Renshaw's daughter Daisy Downing's reminiscences, and a suggestion that if Elderslea closed, Upper Hutt's maternity services would be back to 'square one'. It was printed yet again on July 31, 1990; this time with an article from an interview with her son, Peter Renshaw, on his memories. In a June 22, 2005 obituary on Sonja Davies, a prominent Labour politician and member of the New Zealand Order of Merit, Peter Renshaw mentioned that she has been born in this house in 1923, and was an occasional visitor with her mother, Gwladys Vile. The article said Mrs Renshaw had started the Upper Hutt Plunket branch in November 1923, and that the hospital had closed in the late 1920s when health-department rules toughened.

Fires – A fire at Upper Hut early yesterday morning totally destroyed a five roomed dwelling owned and occupied by Mr F Renshaw. The house burned fiercely and the occupants just had time to escape in their night attire. The building was insured for £800 and the furniture and effects for £200 both in the State Fire Office.

Their marriage was solemnised at Kilbirnie said Walter Horace Stewart Cole who asked the court to order his wife to return to him. He told his counsel Mr Percy Jackson that he married Loveday Alice Louisa on 21 September 1917. They lived together at various places round Wellington. In answer to his counsel Cole said he was known as Frank Renshaw. He last lived with his wife at Upper Hutt. His wife took up nursing and in April of this year she failed to return home. He wrote and asked her to return to the conjugal hearth but she refused hence his appeal to the court. He was employed by the Wellington City Council but he had a lovely home at the Hutt until it was burnt down about a month ago. If his wife would return to him he was prepared to build another home to her own plans as he sincerely wanted her back. His Honor made the desired order which had to be obeyed within fourteen days.
