Thomas Weatherly, alias Brown, a rough looking fellow, was charged with having on Wednesday last, at the Silverstream, assaulted George Washington Schwartz. He was further charged with an assault upon George Marcus Schwartz, the first prosecutor's son. The prisoner had been, taken on the farm at Silverstream to do odd jobs, and had been very kindly treated. At first he was very willing and did his work, but latterly had become lazy, and ultimately violent, and had demanded in filthy language wages at £1 per week. The eider prosecutor offered him 10s to go away, which he refused. Disputes as to money matters arose, and the prisoner knocked the father down from behind, threatening to brain him with a big stone. The son came to the father's rescue, and received a severe gash upon his face. The prisoner was at last secured and taken to the Hutt, where Constable Withers found two large boulders in his pockets. In his defence the prisoner accused the elder prosecutor of "besting" him out of money. Mr Shaw said that the prisoner was fortunate in not being charged with an assault with intent to commit grievous bodily harm a charge much more serious than those with which he was charged. No doubt he was under the influence of drink at the time, but the life and property of up country settlers must be

protected. Prisoner was sentenced to four weeks hard labour on the first charge, and six months upon the second.

The many friends of Mr George Washington Schwartz will regret to hear that he passed away suddenly on 29 November in his 76th year. Mr Schwartz was born in Hamburg Germany, in 1832 and arrived in Wellington in the early fifties where for 18 years he was confidential clerk to the Hon. John Martin. Later he was a resident at the Hutt for many years and for the last 18 months has resided in Palmerston North. Deceased leaves a wife and two grown-up daughters to mourn their loss. An inquest in connection with the death of Mr Schwartz was held before the District Coroner (Captain Mowlem) to-day. Dr Martin deposed that he was called in at 6.30 vesterday morning. He found deceased, dead and the indications were that death was due to natural causes. All the indications pointed to his having had a failing heart for some time. Janet Schwartz wife of deceased also gave evidence, stating that deceased appeared to be in good health the previous evening. Deceased woke up on Sunday morning just after midnight, and asked for a drink of water. He said he felt as if he were choking. Witness propped him up with some cushions and remained with him till the morning, when he expired suddenly. Deceased was 76 years of age, and had always enjoyed good health.
