## Evening Post newspaper 02 March 1904

The Upper Hutt - Mr. John Wilkin, now of the Lower Hutt, where his figure is a familiar one on the local Magisterial Bench, stands, out prominently as an authority on matters pertaining to the growth of Upper Hutt. The timber in the grand forest that once covered the land was of the very best and Mr Wilkin, as a sawyer, can give an expert opinion. The timbers chiefly used were matai, rimu, and totara, and there was probably no better forest in the colony. Many of the trees were 100 feet high, and the totara of which there was plenty, was five and six feet through. But there as low down the valley, the floods did great damage, and carried away much of the richest land. The timber industry was the mainstay of the place for a long time. The price of timber then

ran up to about 12s 6d per 100 feet in Wellington, as it cost nearly as much to get it to town as the price paid at the mill. The best men at the mills got 7s a day, but 5s was the average. Mr Wilkin has earned as much as £10 a week sawing, and he had a contract with two sawmills for seven years, during which he averaged about £1 a day. It cost from 2s to 2s 6d a hundredweight to get goods up from Wellington. Beef was sixpence a pound, mutton eight pence, flour went as high as £2 a cwt, a little Dutch cheese would cost 10s 6d, while 28s was the cost of a very rough pair of boots, locally made. Clothes also were very dear. Among the oldest buildings in the district now are those where once Cruickshank's sawmill ran merrily by water power. These are now much "dilapidated. Mr Cruickshank was sent out by Lord Peteis [sic] to manage the mill. The unoccupied dwelling-house situated on the line site at the back of the old mill has it is strange to learn in this prosaic age the reputation among the superstitious of being haunted. The orchard in the adjoining grounds looks far more as though it has been haunted.

The funeral takes place this afternoon Mr John Wilkins, an old resident of the Hutt Valley, who died on Thursday at his home in Bloomfield Crescent, Lower Hutt, was born in the Parish of Inkerrow, County of Worcester, England in 1827. He arrived in New Zealand by the Oliver Lang in 1856, and was in partnership with a Mr Yule in Featherston for some time as a contractor in delivering timber to the sawmills. Subsequently he was engaged in business for a few years at Upper Hutt, and for the last fifty years he resided quietly in Lower Hutt. He served the public faithfully for many as a Justice of the Peace, and with the late Mr John Cudby, JP, frequently officiated at the local Police Court. He was twice married. His first wife died over fifty years ago, and his second fourteen years ago. He is survived by the two daughters of his first wife, who kept house for him and nursed him during the last year. He was connected with the Wellington Racing Club for thirty years, the greater part of the time as steward and clerk of the scales, in which capacity he has weighed out most of the leading horsemen in the Dominion, and no clerk of the scales was better known to riders of the old school. He was also one of the trustees of the Hutt Park Racecourse. Before coming to the Dominion he was a cricketer, and throughout his life he took a great interest in all kinds of sport, winning a foot race at the age of 63.
