George William WOOD was a butcher who built a house named "Acrefield" now situated at 4 Clyma Street Ebdentown Upper Hutt. Acrefield House is now known as Elderslea Manor. The house was built in the 1940s from a 1939 American New York World Fair design by a local George WOODS. In 2023 it was part of a Bed and Breakfast accommodation.

It has been told that George William WOOD established the Broadway shopping complex and that he opened a butcher shop in the complex.
