Robert WYETH was born 14 October 1814 Jamaica. This is according to information from Robert's obituary.

Robert WYETH departed England 31 July 1839 on the ship "Cuba" and arrived 03 January 1840 in Petone New Zealand.

Upon arriving in the Hutt Valley Robert Wyeth was employed by the New Zealand Company as a surveyor's assistant.

County Court Wellington - Tuesday 19 July – 4<sup>th</sup> session  
Robert WYETH indicated for stealing a cock and hen the property of Stephen Hartly value eight shillings.  
Emma Hartly sworn - I am daughter to Stephen Hartly, who is a Gunsmith, and lives on Lambton Quay. I know, the prisoner at the bar, he lives near our house, I went into his house on a Sunday morning about eight weeks ago, he was standing inside the house plucking a fowl in hot water, the water steamed, I knew it to be our little cock, I knew it by the feathers about the neck; he was plucking the neck when I came in, and directly he saw me come in he turned it into the water to the part mostly plucked. I said nothing but went in and told my mother, I went out to look for our cock, was about the hills as we had not missed it then, I did not find it then, but I found, a feather, which I picked up and brought to my father I found it near the prisoners kitchen door; I knew it because it was a pet cock of mine, and used to feed it out of my hand. – Cross examined by Dr Evans - This is about eight weeks, since because my brother left our house six weeks, and it was about a fortnight before that on Thursday last, I was brought to the Police office to make this charge, I never was brought there before, my father went with me, I had no conversation with Mr

Rowland Davis about this business at any time, I have never seen him at our house, I don't know that I have, I knew that Mr Wyeth had; bought some fowls, but these were all killed at the time I saw him plucking our fowl, he had some hens at that time, I saw some of the fowls, he bought of Mr Houghton, to the best of my knowledge they were all cocks, the fowl we lost was a red and brown colour, but I cannot say if the prisoner had any of that colour, I went into the prisoners kitchen with a message from my mother, the kitchen door was shut, I opened the door myself, there was Mr Wyeth there and a servant, the fowl was about half-plucked, the bird we lost was between four and five months old, I had some talk with Johanna Connell, after I went home on Friday, I never talked with her until I had left the Court-house, she never told me what she was going to say, I have talked with Mr Brown since I went up to the Court, I saw Mr Burgess come to our house on Wednesday, my father and mother and the servant were present, there were a person came, and spoke to my mother, it was a women, but I should not like to mention her name, I dare say it will vex her if I mention her name, it was Mrs O'Connell if I must tell you, It was only once she came, I don't think I did speak to her myself, I have not seen Mr R Davies at our house since this occurred, I have seen him go to my father's workshop, the fowl was bred by us, I knew it well, it was the smallest chicken we had there were, a few flat feathers not plucked under the wing, which was the same as our chicken.

Stephen Hartley sworn - I am a gunsmith, I live at Lambton-quay, I had some poultry about eight weeks ago, one was a red and brown, it is nine weeks more or less, since we saw it last, I think it was on a Saturday when I saw it last the cock we missed was molting, a feather was brought in by our daughter, it was the same colour as that of ours, the feather was a young feather, the quill was quite soft, we said nothing about it thought it was a frivolous thing until I was brought to the Court. Cross examined by Dr Evans - We sent for the prisoner to speak to him about it, but he was engaged and could not come, we did not mention the fowl to him, I never spoke to him about it, until I was brought to the Police-office, I never had any conversation with Mr R Davis about this affair that I recollect.

Johanna Connell sworn - I am servant to Mr Wyeth I was in his service about eight weeks ago, I saw a fowl dead, with feathers on it in the fowl-house it was a cock, I saw it on a Saturday between three and four o'clock, he coaxed another one in on the Sunday morning, and killed it, it was a brown one with a few blue spots on it, the one he coaxed in was not his own, he had fowls, but they were black ones, the prisoner brought in the fowl which I saw dead on Saturday, and plucked it, this was on Sunday morning, he put it in some hot water.

Cross examined - The prisoner had some fowls at that time, they were black ones, some had white wings, he bought 18 cocks of Mr Houghton, I don't know if there were any red ones amongst them, he had killed all these at the time the cock was seen by me, on the Saturday, he always used hot water, the cock which was plucked on the Sunday morning, was a brown one, I know nothing else about it, I lived with Mr and Mrs Wyeth, I quitted 1st of July, I was discharged, I don't know whether Mr Wyeth ever charged me with robbing him, one day I remember there was a charge against me for stealing, a two-shilling piece, that I had received the money, I remember a girl named Martha lived at Mr Wyeth's, I never advised, Martha to steal, a loaf, as it would not be missed, Emma Hartly came in to buy a piece of parsley and mentioned the fowl, I did not know to whom either the fowls belonged to. I have had no conversation with any one until I came here to be witness. Was you ever accused of stealing a pair of boots? The witness, refused to answer any more questions.

Rowland Davies sworn - I never had any conversation with the last witness, Emma Hartly, about this business, I knew the witness, Emma Hartly, by sight only, I never spoke to Johanna Connell until the day before she was discharged by Mr Wyeth, I never had any conversation, with Johanna about this business.

Dr Taylor sworn - I live at Te Aro, corner of Willis Street and Manners Street, I know the prisoner at the bar, he lives near me, I have known him twelve months, I trust him, and believe him to be an honest man.

James Seller sworn - I am a, baker I live at Te Aro, I have known the prisoner about twelve months, I have had little to do with him in the way of business, I always gave him credit for so much as he wanted, I never heard anything prejudicial to his character before.

J J Batton sworn - I am a wheelwright, I know the prisoner at the bar, I have known him three years, I never heard anything against him, never heard any complaint of him.

Verdict - Not guilty

To his Excellency Edward John Eyre Esquire Lieutenant Governor in and over the Southern Division in HM Colony of New Zealand the humble Memorial of Robert Wyeth of Lambton Quay Wellington in the Province of New Zealand Storekeeper - Herewith.

That your Memorial is desirous of Establishing a Public house situated upon the Section number "81" in the Upper Hutt District a Moiety of which said section is the freehold Property of your Memorialist.

That your Memorialist will within three months from the date hereof erect a substantial building, in order that the public may obtain the usual accommodation of a Road side Inn. Your Memorialists refers your Excellency to the Memorial and Settlers who have attached their names to the recommendation hereunto annexed and prays that a licence may be granted for the Sale of Spirituous Liquor wine ale and beer agreeably to the Premises of the amended Licensing Ordinance on such terms and conditions as your Excellency and the Council shall deem meet and should your Memorialist obtain a Licence will enter into the required recognisance and your Memorialist.

Robert WYETH held the publican licence for the Barley Mow Inn in Silverstream from about 1858 to 1860. The property was situated near the old Silverstream Hospital and entrance to the Land fill.

Robert had built other dwellings on the land. Three of the dwellings were occupied by Mr Stannaway, Mr Hagan and Mr Sollary and their families. In January 1858 it rained heavy and the Hutt River overflowed and the three dwellings and their families were swept away with the loss of 13 lives.

Wellington Independent newspaper 20 January 1858

The Hutt - [From our Correspondent] Hutt 10th January 1858 - On the East side of the Remutaka, some 20 slips have taken place and it will take fifty pounds to clear and repair the road to its former position. On the west side of the hill little injure is done, five pounds will reinstate it in its former position. The Pakaratahi [sic] river rose about 5 feet higher than it had been known to do upon any former occasion. Hodder's had great difficulty in saving their horses from being drowned. It will take fifty pounds to repair the damage done to the road between Hodder's and Collin's. Mr Collins has lost all his sheep and has found 53 carcasses. The river was ten feet higher than he had ever known it before. Upon crossing the Mungaroo, the river had been 6 and 8 feet above the main line of road. Nearly opposite Petre's Saw Mill, the river has made new channels, and has swept whole fields of grain and Potatoes away. On this side of the Mill the main road is blocked up with the wreck of houses and drift timber. The Maoris' were picking out their apparel and goods to dry. Some of the Pakeha's whose dwellings were washed away, it is said, would have lost their lives had it not been for the Maoris'. From six to ten feet of water has been rushing over the road. Mr Barton has lost a considerable number of sheep, all the Maori Pa's were well supplied with a number of sheep's carcasses. Near the silver stream the devastation becomes more apparent, the fences are gone, huge pieces of timber lay across the road, the crops are borne down and at the East abutment of the Bridge is a log stretched across the road about six feet in diameter, but upon reaching Wyeth's, the force of the flood is marked, not only by the disappearance of dwellings but by the loss of life. The flood at the Silver Stream first rushes across the road in a South East direction and then rolls back to the river at Wyeth's, and such was the force of the flood that it carried away several dwellings belonging to Mr Wyeth and the inmates, who were drowned, to the number of 13. At 5 pm 7 bodies had been found and a Coroner's Inquest is to sit at 2 o'clock this day the 20th, upon their bodies. The following are the names given of those that are drowned. Mr Stannaway, wife and five children, Mr Charles Sillary, his wife and child, Mrs Hagin and her new born infant, also Mrs Price the nurse, a person named Hartley, succeeded in swimming up a tree and saved his life by hanging to the tree about 14 hours. The bodies found are, Mr Sillary, wife and child, Mrs Hagin (Mr Dew's daughter), Mrs Price, with the infant in her arms, only born at six o'clock the same morning, and one of Mr Stannaway's little girls, about six or seven years old, six of Mr Stannaway's family are not yet found. Four of the bodies are at Blade's, the Traveller's and three at Mr Dew's. No lives were lost at the lower Hutt, but considerable damage has been done to property. The Aglionby Arms is tipped endways into the river, and the river has found a new course near Buckridge. Public house. The Hutt Bridge stands but the Waiwetu is carried from the piles and swept away.

Narrow Escape of Mr R Wyeth - A fire occurred about 6 o'clock, last evening, at a house, situated in Church Street, occupied by Mrs Byrn, and owned by Mr James Nicol. The outbreak took place in the front room, and fortunately was discovered when in an incipient state, otherwise the Fire Brigade would have experienced greater difficulty in extinguishing the flames, and also preventing them from spreading to the neighbouring residences. Several members of the Central Brigade were at the scene within a few minutes, and a water plug being located just opposite the house, they lost no time in getting a good stream of water on to the flames, which were confined to the front room. The cause of the outbreak is believed to have been caused by the head of a match which had been struck by Mr R Wyeth who occupies the front room, igniting the bed curtains. Miss Byrn, when taking Mr Wyeth's tea into his room, found the old gentleman in a helpless state on the floor, but she at once got him from the room, though not before his arms and legs had been considerably burned. Had it not been for Miss Byrn's prompt and self-

possessed action, Mr Wyeth, who is ninety years of age and very infirm, must have received more serious, and perhaps fatal injuries. He is however, progressing favourably, although last night it was feared that the shock might produce serious consequences. When the ignited match-head lit on the bed curtains, the old gentleman was unable to raise an alarm, as he is now losing his voice. Everything around him his chair, crutches, and the clothes he was wearing were partially burnt, and it is almost a miracle that he was not burnt to death. A rather singular feature in connection with the matter is that Mr Wyeth has all his life been proverbial for his extreme caution about fire, and the accident which occurred was one that no possible precaution could have avoided. Had the old gentleman been able to summon assistance, the fire would have been promptly extinguished, but under the circumstances, the marvel is that Mr Wyeth was not suffocated, or burnt to death.

Obituary - Mr Robert Wyeth - A Pioneer of the Early Days - Time, with its remorseless scythe, has thinned out the ranks of the pioneer colonists, till now but few remain, and the latest to join the great majority is Mr Robert Wyeth, an old resident of Masterton. The deceased, who was born in Jamaica (where his father had an extensive plantation), in October of 1814, came out to New Zealand in the barque Cuba, of 274 tons, with the first Imperial survey party sent out under Captain Smith to survey the town of Britannia (now Petone). The party landed on the Petone beach in December 1839, deceased at that time being about twenty five years of age. The late Mr Wyeth remained with the survey party for some time, but later set up a general store on what was then known as Warmoll's Corner, and is now the corner of Willis and Manners streets. This was the first business started in Wellington, and all produce and goods was conveyed to the vessels in a wheelbarrow. The deceased was the first person to get married in Wellington, he being married about nine months after his arrival in the Colony to a Miss Runalls, who came out in the Duke of Roxburgh two weeks later than the Cuba. Deceased's wife predeceased him exactly seventeen years ago this month. At the time of his marriage jewellers were a *vara avis*, but not to be baffled in respect to a wedding ring, deceased got the centre of a sovereign bored out, and got a ring in that way, which is in the possession of the family at the present time. His marriage notice also appeared in the first paper printed in New Zealand.



The late Mr Wyeth later on went to the Upper Hutt, where besides taking up land and engaging in farming, he established a blacksmith's shop, as well as building several houses. In the Hutt he remained twelve years, but lost his all in the memorable flood of 1858. He retired to rest in the evening a comparatively rich man, only to awake in the morning absolutely ruined. At this time he returned to Wellington, and subsequently settled in Masterton thirty years ago, retiring from business ten years ago. The deceased has had a good deal of buffeting about, but he bravely withstood it all. He was full of reminiscences of his early experiences, and for a man of his age had a remarkably good memory. Deceased has a grown up family of nine, five sons and four daughters, and include Messrs George Wyeth (Kurupuni), Thomas Wyeth (Opaki), Charles Wyeth (Woodlands, Canterbury), Joseph Wyeth (Wellington), John Wyeth (Foxton), and Mrs Gorrige, Mrs A McLeod, Mrs W Harris, and Mrs J L Murray, all of Masterton.
