An early address recorded the property as number 12 Bridge road. Bridge Road was once part of Akatarawa Road and was also known as Reid Road after the saw-miller Donald REID. (Reference Akatarawa A History of the Sawyers, Settlers and Schools 1870-1980s by Peter O'Flaherty 2022 publication)

Folk lore records that the house at number 55 Bridge Road Birchville in Akatarawa was once a home for unmarried mothers owned by the CLARK family.

The Clark's dwelling in Bridge Road was also a children foster home and sometimes referred to by the Government officials as a receiving home.

William CLARKE sometimes spelt CLARKE and his wife Ruby took care of the foster children. The Mungaroa School later renamed Te Marua School record William as the children's guardian. The school was originally spelt Mungaroa. In other early records it was spelt Maungaroa but the correct spelling is Mangaroa.

The CLARK property is a pre-1900 building! As early as 1892 the school records record the children's parent or guardian address as Akatarawa Upper Hutt. The current valuation records record that the property was built in 1915. I have found other Upper Hutt properties with the incorrect building year on valuation records.

For the majority of the children I have been unable to locate their birth registration with parents recorded as Ruby and William. This makes me believe that these children were born in the home for unmarried mothers but bought up by Ruby and William Clark.

Ruby Emily Jane ELSWORTH was born about 1849 London England to parents Jane nee Luke and Edward Elsworth.

The bride's bouquet was of Christmas lilies and white carnations, and that of the bridesmaid was of sweet peas and roses. Mr. Sydney Whiteman officiated as best man and Mrs. J. Gorrie (nee Whiteman) played the Wedding March as the bridal party left the church. The newly-wedded couple received the congratulations of their many friends at the residence of Mrs. W. Clark, Akatarawa road, prior to their departure on a honeymoon trip to Auckland and the Hot Lakes. The bride's going-away dress was a navy blue tailor made costume and she wore a black hat with a white ostrich feather The bridegroom's present to the bridesmaid was a gold brooch set wj.th rubies and turquoise.
