World War One Deaths in date order

During World War One Gallipoli, Somme and Passchendaele record deaths of service personnel associated with the Upper Hutt district. The deaths below are listed in date order with a few theatres of war mentioned around the same time period.

It was a dark day for the Upper Hutt Community on 08 August 1915 at Chunuk Bair where many local men were reported missing, believed to be killed in action. Some of the service personnel were mentioned in Wellington newspaper articles and others in the local newspaper the '*Hutt Valley Independent*'.

Hutt Valley Independent newspaper 11 September 1915

*Word has been received that **Harry Bickens** (ex-porter at Upper Hutt) and **George Russell** (formerly of Kaitoke station) were killed on August 8 and that **Robert C Dunn** (brother of J H Dunn Silverstream), **Claude Simpson** (of the Mangaroa Druids' Lodge) and **Harry Ward** (brother of Norman Ward and step-brother of J Harrison of Upper Hutt) were reported Missing and believed to have been killed on the same day.*

The war officially ended on 11 November 1918 and the New Zealand Service personnel began to return home. At the same time a deadly strand of Influenza made its appearance in New Zealand. It would be commonly known as the Spanish influenza pandemic.

There were 177 deaths at the Featherston Military Camp.

Locally in the Upper Hutt district there were 12 deaths. In the neighbourhood was the Trentham Military Camp were 77 service personnel died of Influenza.

Cemeteries and Memorials in New Zealand

Some Service Personnel died in New Zealand after discharge from wounds or disease received while on active service. Others died in New Zealand while training from accidents or disease including the Influenza pandemic. These service personnel were buried in New Zealand cemeteries and the majority met the Commonwealth War Graves and New Zealand Defence Force criteria.

The families of these service personnel could visit the New Zealand graves. Unfortunately most Upper Hutt families have been unable to visit the overseas graves or memorials and stand in front of the headstone or memorial of their loved ones.

Many who died in New Zealand (while serving or after discharge from disease or wounds received while serving) are not recorded on any district memorials. Of the one hundred and nine (109) service personnel listed below, some have strong, while others have weak association with the Upper Hutt district.
