The New Zealand Cross is an award peculiar to New Zealand and the Second Maori War of 1860-1872. It is one of the rarest decorations in the world, only 23 having been awarded. Instituted by the Governor of New Zealand by Order in Council dated March 10, 1869, it met an urgent need for some decoration equivalent to the Victoria Cross for which the local Militia had been considered ineligible. The Governor, Sir George Bowen, awarded five of the crosses before Royal approval for the award had been obtained. Queen Victoria had little option under the circumstances but to ratify the Order in Council, which merely referred to the new award as a "Decorative Distinction" without giving it a name. The title New Zealand Cross was not adopted for some time. In the interim it was referred to as the 'New Zealand Cross of Valour, Order of Valour, Order of Merit, Order of the Southern Cross, Cross of New Zealand, Colonial Cross, Southern Cross, and Silver Cross.' The institution of the cross can be attributed to Colonel G. S. Whitmore who on November 19, 1868 requested that a sum of money be made available from the Armed Constabulary Reserve Fund for the purchase of 20 rosettes and special chevrons to be awarded to members of the Armed Constabulary who distinguished themselves in action and to whom a monetary grant of \$10 should be made from the same fund. From this modest request the idea developed into the New Zealand Cross as instituted. It was laid down that the decoration should consist of a silver cross with the name of the colony and the name of the recipient engraved thereon and be suspended from the left breast by a crimson riband. A Roll of Recipients was kept with brief descriptive of acts of valour. Under certain circumstances such as cowardice or a disgraceful act, the name of the recipient was to be erased from the roll. Although the first recipient of the Cross, Constable Henare Kepa Te Ahururu, later deserted, his name was not taken off the roll. The list of recipients has many connections with Wanganui. Trooper William Languard of Kai Iwi Cavalry Volunteers won his at Tauranga-a-ika on December 28, 1868. Major Keepa Te Rangihiwinui (Kemp) won his for gallantry at Moturoa November 7, 1868 and Otauto on March 13, 1869. He died at Wanganui on April 15, 1898. Sergeant Samuel Austin, Wanganui Volunteer Corps, was awarded his for gallantry on January 7, 1866 at Putahi Pa, and on October 17, 1866, at Keteonetea. He died at Wanganui on January 25, 1903. Private Thomas Adamson of the Corps of Guides, won his at Ahikereru on May 7, 1869, and he died at Wanganui on November 8, 1899. Of these New Zealand Crosses, one was sent to London and sold at Southeby's, one went to Taranaki Museum, one to Rotorua Museum, and one was reputed to have been buried with the nephew of a winner. It is unfortunate that none of these medals came to the Wanganui Museum. There is a mystery regarding the actual number of medals in existence. The dies of the New Zealand Cross had been left in the hands of Phillips Bros. and Sons, of London, who completed the final order of five in 1886, making a total of 25 struck ostensibly for awards. A few suitable engraved specimens were authorised to be struck for the Royal Mint Museum, and for eminent medal collectors in England. However, the dies passed through two other hands before they were recovered by the Agent-General in 1908. In the intervening years a number of unauthorised specimens were struck. One of these specimen medals even had the name of Trooper Languard of the Kai lwi Cavalry emblazoned on it but it does not bear the Phillip's cartouche and the original still exists. In 1885 the Premier proposed that the New Zealand Cross should be extended for award to those who were responsible for saving human life. It was suggested that to distinguish it from the Military medal, the stars should be omitted from the Cross, and the ribbon should be a different colour. The proposal was dropped when it was found the Royal Humane Society of Australasia, founded in 1882, had such a medal.
