And Ches.), I 145. Various members of the family holding under the Standish part of the manor paid to the fifteenth in 1577, John Scholes contributing as a mesne tenant,; Shaw, 29 John Scholes died in 1589, holding a message and 23acres called Okeden of the lords of the manor in socage by a rent of 6d., leaving a son and heir John, aged over thirty-eight in 1619; Lancs. Inq. P.m. (Rec. Soc. Lancs. and Ches.) ii, 147. This John Scholes died in 1630, holding the same lands, and leaving as heir his son William, over twenty-three years of age; Towneley MS. C. 8, 13 (Chet. Lib.), p. 1081-2. Robert Scholes contributed to the subsidy in 1622; Misc. (ut sup.), I, 157 Richard and William Scholes were two of the four presenting the names of those liable to be assessed in Chadderton in 1641; Shaw's Assessment, 14; see also Shaw Oldham, 153. 155, 171. :The late Mr S.
